PETER GLEASON, Managing Director and CFO, NACD

Mr. Gleason also serves as Treasurer for the NACD Board of Directors and as Chief Operating Officer of the Center for Board Leadership, a joint venture between NACD and its six Alliance Partners. He is a member of NACD’s national faculty and is a frequent presenter on the subjects of corporate governance, executive and director compensation, hostile corporate transactions, board evaluation, and strategic planning.
